Undoubtedly, you heard that all events, meetings and performances until September 1, 2020 are cancelled. This national measure to combat the Covid-19 virus (Corona virus) is necessary to ensure that as many people as possible remain safe and healthy.

#### What does this mean for you?

You have tickets for one or more of the cancelled performances in June 2020. At this point you don't have to do anything yet. The team at Theater aan het Vrijthof is hard at work in trying to reschedule performances that currently cannot go ahead as well making all the necessary preparations. In case, a performance cannot be rescheduled, or if you are not able to attend the show on the alternative date, you will be offered a voucher for the value of the ticket(s) purchased. Understandably, if you have any reason for not wanting to use this scheme, you can ask for a refund.

As we have to deal with so many performances and tickets sold, we request that you do not contact our UITbalie and trust that we will inform you in person in the forthcoming month.
